ATARI 400/800/XL AND 130XE

This disk is formatted in DOS 2.5 which is compatible with 2.0 and 3.0 machines.

To run "THE LOTTO PROGRAM" just boot DOS 2.5 from another disk then insert the LOTTO disk and type RUN "D:LOTTO.PGM" and press return. The program comes in the 6/40 mode. This means it is configured for a lotto game where they pick 6 out of 40 numbers each drawing. If your state is different, like 6/44 or 6/36 for example, you must reconfigure the program to suit before starting to use it. There is a CONFIG program on the disk which will change the LOTTO.PGM to any format between 30 and 49 (highest number used in the game). To re-configure the program just type RUN "D:CONFIG.PGM" and press return. Just follow the instructions on the screen. As soon as it is finished re-run the LOTTO.PGM and it will be ready to start entering the past winning numbers.

There is a TUTOR program on the disk which will instruct you on how to use "THE LOTTO PROGRAM". Just type RUN "D:TUTOR.PGM".

When the disk is first purchased the data file is either blank or contains *invalid* numbers for test purposes only. So the first thing you must do is type in the 30 past winners to build your active data base, then you merely add the latest winner each time there's a drawing and keep it up to date. The past winners may be obtained from your lotto agent where you buy tickets or from publications that provide that service. Typing them in only takes about 10 minutes even for a slow typist. Also this acquaints you with the operation of the **LOTTO PROGRAM**.

When typing the numbers in be sure to start with the *oldest* winners first (the furthest back) and build up to the *latest* one. If you make mistakes you can use the change feature to correct them.

Keep in mind that playing a state in which you do not reside could be *illegal* so check your state laws before doing so.
